













And so what?

- WS-* services are powerful but they introduce a large overhead, and are not easy to build upon
- REST is simple, loosely-coupled but can become complex for complicated use cases
- For an Internet of Things WS-* is not always the right approach
- The Web of Things alternative seems quite interesting
 - Good for ad hoc, tactical applications [1]
 - Mashup physical devices
 - Physical World become part of the web (of the things)

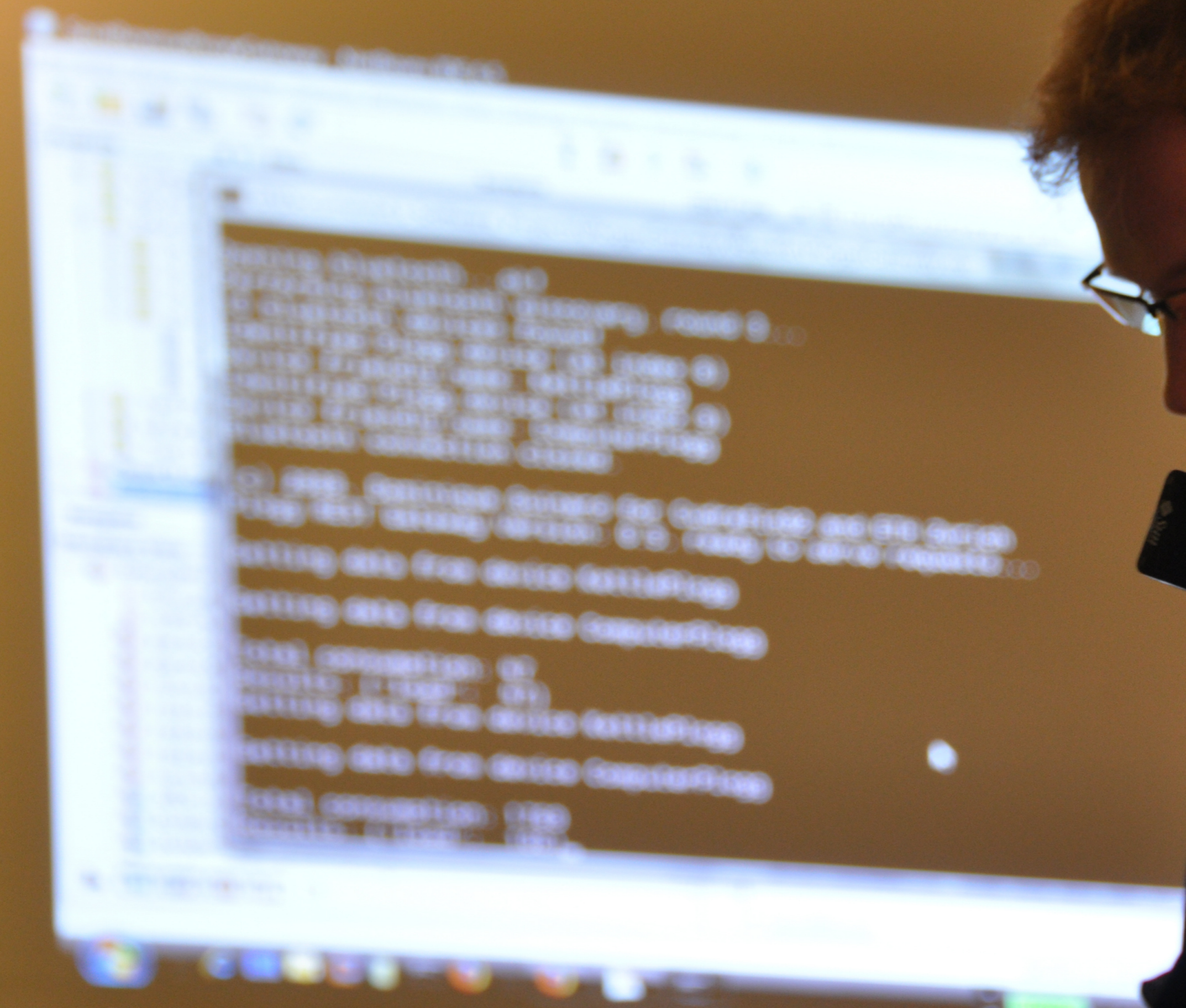
